## COPYRIGHT LAW

**Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected.**

For example, no artworks depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted. All artworks must be original ideas and created entirely by the student.

Students PreK-12 are invited to submit original artwork to be displayed at the [ASCD Conference on Teaching Excellence](#), June 29 – July 1, 2017 in Denver.

All art will be eligible for judging in a “People’s Choice” award at the gala opening event on June 29. Attendees will be asked to vote for the art that best illustrates each tenet of the Whole Child.

There will be a finalist selected for art depicting each of the Whole Child Tenets that receives the most votes:

### Healthy

Each student enters school healthy and learns about and practices a healthy lifestyle.

### Safe

Each student learns in an environment that is physically and emotionally safe for students and adults.

### Engaged

Each student is actively engaged in learning and is connected to the school and broader community.

### Supported

Each student has access to personalized learning and is supported by qualified, caring adults.

### Challenged

Each student is challenged academically and prepared for success in college or further study and for employment and participation in a global environment.

▶ Additionally, a “Best of Show” Award will be given to the artwork receiving the most votes overall.

▶ Finalists will each receive a certificate, and “Best of Show” will be awarded a ribbon.

## Media and Technique Requirements

Any of the following media or techniques may be used:

- Paint (watercolor, tempera, poster, acrylic, etc.)
- Drawing materials (pencil, charcoal, colored chalk, pastels, oil pastels, colored pencils, markers, etc.)
- Collage materials (cut and glued papers, such as construction paper, tissue paper, wrapping paper, aluminum foil, etc.)
- Prints (handmade stencils, gadget printing, collographs, block prints, etc.)
- Original digital illustration
- Photography
